Piotr Zimmerman graduated from the Faculty of Law and Administration of the University of Szczecin, (1990–1995). He completed legal training in court and started his professional career as a judge (1997–2006). He used to be a judge at bankruptcy courts in Szczecin and Warsaw and for many years acted as a judge-commissioner in the largest bankruptcy proceedings in Poland (including of Stocznia Szczecińska S.A.). Since 2012 he has been involved in the legislative work of subsequent Teams for Amendment of Bankruptcy and Reorganisation Law at the Ministry of Justice and is a coauthor of the Restructuring Law of 15 May 2015.

Currently, he is a legal counsel (since 2007) and a licensed restructuring adviser (since 2014). He has extensive experience in representing debtors and creditors in proceedings aimed at executing arrangement in procedures provided for in the restructuring law (previously reorganisation and bankruptcy arrangement law). At Zimmerman Filipiak Restrukturyzacja S.A., he serves as a judicial supervisor and administrator in restructuring cases.

In recent years, he has acted as a court supervisor or administrator in several notable restructuring proceedings, including: RUCH S.A. (where accelerated arrangement proceedings led to an arrangement with creditors in 2019), Termisil Huta Szkła Wołomin S.A. (composition proceedings concluded with an approved arrangement in 2019), and Piotr i Paweł Group companies (composition proceedings, with arrangements approved in 2020 and beyond).

He also engages in teaching and research activities and has authored numerous publications on corporate restructuring and bankruptcy.
